Introduction to the 'International CM Day'

Background to the Establishment of the 'International CM Day'

- 25th~29th October 2009 - CMAK' Chairman Bae was invited to the CMAA National Conference held in Orlando, US. On October 25, Chairman Bae attended the CMAA board meeting and gave a presentation on the topic of 'CM : The Present and the Future in Korea' and on the same day, proposed the establishment of an 'International CM Day'.
- 6th~12th March 2010 - CMAA International Committee suggested a detailed discussion be held on the topic of the 'International CM Day' at the IDCM Forum in Bangkok, Thailand in March 2010
- 7th March 2010 - At the IDCM Forum in Bangkok, Thailand, representatives from CMAK, CMAA and CIOB agreed to designate the second Monday of March each year as the 'International CM Day'.
- IPMA and CMAJ expressed interest in the participation of the 'International CM Day' and became participating organizations of the 'International CM Day'.
- 30th April 2010 - At the 2010 CM Seoul Forum & Global CM Contest, 5 CM related associations, CMAK, CMAA, CMAJ, CIOB and IPMA proclaimed the second Monday of March each year to be the 'International CM Day' and all parties signed "The Declaration of International CM Day". All parties agreed to work together to encourage as many construction related associations as possible around the world to participate in the 'International CM Day'. All celebrations for the day are to take place in respective countries. Hosting of an international event to celebrate the day where associations around the world gather together in one place, is to be discussed and agreed upon.

- Establish a network to share and exchange CM related information and resources
- Encourage a sense of belonging and responsibility and thereby boost the morale of all CM professionals

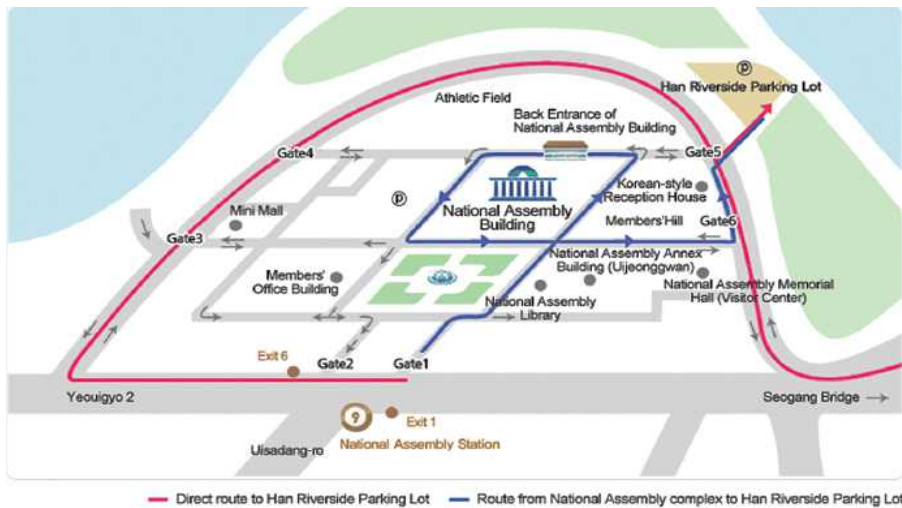
